It calculates rest hours and automatically checks compliance with international and national legislation. The Navigator Shore portal allows for office monitoring of work & rest non-compliance.

Purpose

Navigator Port's Work & Rest module provides an efficient way of supporting and monitoring compliance with relevant international and national legislation on seafarers' work & rest hours.

Features

The module supports compliance with the:

- Maritime Labour Convention 2006
- ILO Convention (No. 180) concerning Seafarers' Hours of Work and the Manning of Ships
- STCW - 95 (Standard of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers) incl. Manila amendments 2010
- US OPA 90 (Oil Pollution Act of 1990)
- OCIMF's Guidelines governing Seafarers' Hours of Work & Rest

Any violation of rules and regulations is clearly identified and marked.

The system allows user-defined:

- Reporting periods
- Remarks on violations of rules and regulations
- Types of regular work and overtime

Reporting and recording

- Daily/monthly summary reports of complete crew hours and flagging of violations of rules
- Practical printouts in the official IMO/ILO format for signing by the Master
- The system allows the registration and reporting of regular work and overtime
- Records are locked once they are archived and synchronized with shore
- Individual and summary reports can easily be exported to the Navigator Port's - Shore Monitoring portal for fleet monitoring
